Current Construction Events

(October 19th to October 23th)

1. **Location:** Second/Simcoe St. from Pine to St. Paul St.

Scope of Work: Continued installation of utility duct along the north side of the street.

Continued installation of storm sewers and excavation for road and sidewalk base.

Impacts: Two way traffic will continue to be restricted to the south side of the street to allow construction on the north side of the street to continue. No parking is provided along either side of Second/Simcoe St. to provide for this two way traffic flow.

2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Second to Third St.

Scope of Work: Excavation completed for road and curb base, installation of new fire hydrant and initiate installation of utility duct work. Provide mid block pedestrian crossing for the weekend.

Continuing to remove benches, lights and paving stones.

Impacts: The center block of Hurontario St. will continue to remain closed to most vehicular traffic until the winter shut down.

Upcoming Construction Events

(October 26th to October 30th)

1. **Location:** Second/Simcoe St. from Pine to St. Paul St.

Scope of Work: Complete installation of electrical duct along North side of street and road crossings at the intersections of Hurontario and St. Marie Streets.

Complete storm sewer installation, repair of water services, excavation for curb and sidewalk installation. Start curb and gutter and planter curb installation.

Impacts: At times traffic may be restricted temporarily to one lane of traffic during work for road crossings and construction traffic.

2. **Location:** Hurontario St. from Second to Third St.

Scope of Work: Installation of the utility ducts will continue, installation of storm sewers, irrigation services and utility conduit.

Impacts: The center block of Hurontario St. will continue to remain closed to most vehicular traffic.

How Will My Services Be Affected?

Telephone, hydro, water, cable TV, sewer and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

The Contractor will collect garbage and recycling containers, deliver to the nearest intersecting side street for pickup and return the containers to individual properties on each garbage day while the construction operations interfere with regular garbage/recycling pickup. Please be sure to clearly label your containers so that they can be returned.

Safety

Georgian Paving & Construction is required to conduct the work in a safe manner, including fencing of the work area, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.

Who Do I Call If I Have a Problem?

The "Project Manager" (Construction) will continue to respond to public inquiries related to this project. The Project Manager should be your first point of contact regarding any construction related concern. You may call or email the Project Supervisor at any time. The Contractor has set up a site office on Hurontario St. that is open Monday to Friday, 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. The Contractor's phone numbers and site office address is provided below. A 24/7 emergency phone number is also provided below but should only be used in emergency or other critical situations.
